GriefWorks on the Move

In September, ***GriefWorks***, a non-profit agency that has provided support and education to grieving individuals and families in Auburn for ten years, will be moving to a new location at Evergreen Community Center, 4910 A Street Southeast, Auburn, WA 98092. The new location has been provided by Evergreen Four Square Church which administrates the community center. Evergreen Community Center is the home to other non-profits such as Evergreen Life Ministries and South Sound Dream Center.

For several years, ***GriefWorks*** has been provided office and meeting space at Skills, Inc., a non-profit organization that has been serving the business community and the disabled community.

Mel Erickson, co-found of ***GriefWorks***, stated, “***GriefWorks*** staff, board members, and volunteers are very appreciative of Evergreen opening its doors and welcoming us. We are thankful for this new home in which we can serve the communities of Auburn, Algona, and Pacific. ***GriefWorks*** serves both King County and Pierce County so the move to south Auburn will be logistically advantageous.”

Since 1998, ***GriefWorks*** has provided healing and hope to over 10,000 people - children, teens, adults, and families. It has brought grief support to schools, homes, and the workplace. ***GriefWorks*** has trained professionals and volunteers in the community, equipping them to further support the bereaved.
